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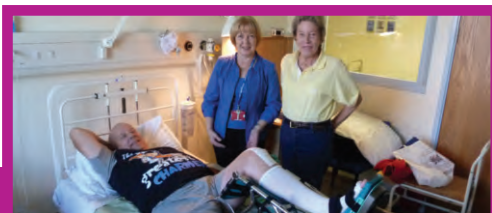
How do we make a difference?

Founded in 1948, the Friends exist to provide funds to support or enhance the resources of St Richard's Hospital and local mental health services in the Chichester area.

Managed and run entirely by volunteers, one of the Friends' main contributions to the day-to-day work of St Richard's Hospital is the provision of a profitable, efficient hospital shop and ward trolley service, offering patients, staff and visitors newspapers, magazines, toiletries, confectionery etc. Funds are raised from legacies, donations, the shop, raffles and special events such as concerts.

These funds are spent mostly on much-needed surgical equipment, such as instruments used in urology. Other purchases include orthopaedic rehabilitation equipment, a diagnostic conferencing system for cardiology, and breast cancer sentinel node analysis equipment for pathology. Additionally, comfortable furniture has been provided and grants made for Christmas gifts and recreational activities for long-stay patients - as well as significant contributions to major projects such as the Fernhurst Cancer Day Unit, the Friends' A & E X-Ray Room, the Eye Day Surgery Unit and Donald Wilson Neurological Rehabilitation Unit.
